



For the Nations DC Job Description: ESOL Teacher (Part-Time or Full-Time)

Job Purpose: To teach English classes, build relationships, and share the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The ESOL instructor has to view this role as a calling to serve in a ministry of love, mercy, and outreach.

Reports To: Director of Adult Education

Work Location, Hours, and Compensation: This can be a part-time or full-time position. You will teach classes at one or more FTN sites in Alexandria, Falls Church, and Fairfax. Salary will be commensurate with experience and agreed upon work hours. *ESOL instructors are responsible to raise individual support for the agreed upon salary and other expenses.*

Primary Responsibilities

- Plan, prepare, and teach relevant and engaging lessons to students from a variety of backgrounds.
- Maintain attendance records
- Conduct assessments, and submit assessment data to the Director of Adult Education
- Help conduct placement testing for students at the beginning of each semester
- Serve in a missional capacity by developing personal relationships with students and their families.

Additional Responsibilities

- Participate in meetings, trainings, and prayer times
- Provide feedback to the Director of Adult Education on teaching materials
- Responsible for raising support and communicating with supporters
- Connect students and their families with local/ community resources as needs arise
- Support other FTN programs as needed

Required Qualifications

- Christian in good standing with his/her local gospel-centered church
- Fully support the mission FTNDC
- Affirm FTNDC's statement of faith
- Satisfactory background check
- Excellent intercultural and interpersonal communication skills
- Experience working with diverse and/or international communities
- Flexible to student's needs/interests
- Strong administrative, computer, and organizational skills

Preferred Qualifications

- TESL/TESOL certified (Certification required to teach but can be obtained after hiring)
- Teaching experience (preferably with background in TESL/TESOL)
- Bachelor's degree

- Experience in working with nonprofits and/or ministries

For the Nations DC Mission and Statement of Faith

All FTNDC staff, volunteers, board members, and partner churches must affirm the following mission statement and statement of faith:

Mission: *To provide English-language instruction and other educational services that help meet the practical needs of refugees, asylees and immigrants, and to share with them the gospel of Jesus Christ.*

Statement of Faith: *“We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen. We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten from the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of the same substance as the Father. Through him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven: by the power of the Holy Spirit he was born of the Virgin Mary, and became man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered, died, and was buried. On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures; he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end. We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father. With the Father and the Son he is worshipped and glorified. He has spoken through the Prophets. We believe in one, holy, universal, and apostolic Church. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We believe in the resurrection of body, and the life everlasting. Amen.”*
