



For the Nations DC Job Description: Children's Worker (Part-Time)

Job Purpose: To provide a safe, loving, and enriching experience for the children of our adult students in order to build relationships and share the gospel of Jesus Christ. The children's worker has to view this role as a calling to serve in a ministry of love, mercy, and outreach.

Reports To: PreSchool Teacher & Classroom Coordinator or Childcare Supervisor

Work Location, Hours, and Compensation:

Minimum of 9 and up to 24 hours. Working hours will vary depending on both your availability and FTN's childcare needs.

Compensation will be \$16/per hour.

Primary Responsibilities

- Provide care for children ages 0 - 5 years old
 - Depending on enrollment or your skills/interests, you will either care for children 0-2 or work do more structured activities for children 3-5 years old
- Treat all children with care and compassion
- Uphold safety standards
- Help lead age-appropriate activities that help children become familiar with English
- Help children with toileting/diaper changes as needed
- Help with setup and cleanup of the childcare space, including sanitizing toys and play spaces.
- Participate in meetings, trainings, and prayer times

Required Qualifications

- Christian in good standing with his/her local gospel-centered church
- Fully support the mission FTNDC
- Affirm FTNDC's statement of faith
- Satisfactory background check
- Physically able to perform tasks, including sitting on the floor, bending, and standing
- Must be able to lift children weighing up to 30 lbs regularly
- Enjoy working with children
- Calm, patient, and engaging demeanor

- Teamplayer
- Excellent intercultural and interpersonal communication skills
- Experience working with diverse and/or international communities

Other Preferred Qualifications

- Early childhood teaching experience
- Experience in working with nonprofits and/or ministries
- Experience working in mixed-age group classrooms
- Child and Infant First Aid/CPR certification

For the Nations DC Mission and Statement of Faith

All FTNDC staff, volunteers, board members, and partner churches must affirm the following mission statement and statement of faith:

Mission: *To provide English-language instruction and other educational services that help meet the practical needs of refugees, asylees and immigrants, and to share with them the gospel of Jesus Christ.*

Statement of Faith: *“We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen. We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten from the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of the same substance as the Father. Through him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven: by the power of the Holy Spirit he was born of the Virgin Mary, and became man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered, died, and was buried. On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures; he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end. We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father. With the Father and the Son he is worshipped and glorified. He has spoken through the Prophets. We believe in one, holy, universal, and apostolic Church. We acknowledge one baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We believe in the resurrection of body, and the life everlasting. Amen.”*
